

April 24, 2018, 7:00 P.M., Greenfield Township Municipal Building, a regular meeting of the Greenfield Township Board of Supervisors.

Present: Steve Rathmann, Sal Fedele, Kevin Bartlett and Renee Wagner.

No public was in attendance.

The Board members and Donald Bement had conducted the road inspections on April 15th. A list of work projects was made. The tailgate spreader needs repaired.

Clean Up days were scheduled for May 4th and May 5th.

The playground equipment has been ordered. The bid packet and master plan were ready for advertisement for bids.

Kevin Bartlett made a motion to adopt Resolution 2018-7 approving the Armstrong Small Flow Treatment Facility on Station Road. Sal Fedele seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

Steve Rathmann made a motion to adopt Resolution 2018-8 approving the Foster Small Flow Treatment Facility on Wilson Road. Kevin Bartlett seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

An Executive Session was held from 7:12 p.m. until 7:46 p.m. to discuss personnel issues. Donald Bement had forwarded a letter of resignation. Richard (Chris) Bisbee was contacted by phone and he stated he would accept appointment as Municipal Services Foreman.

Sal Fedele made a motion to appoint Richard (Chris) Bisbee as Municipal Services Foreman at the rate of \$ 22.25/hour, and to terminate employment of Donald Bement as soon as possible. Employment Law Attorney Dan Miller and Township Solicitor Kurt Sundberg were to be consulted regarding a separation agreement (if necessary) and their recommendations. Kevin Bartlett seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

The Board had reviewed the condition of properties during the road inspection.

Steve Rathmann made a motion to have Attorney Kurt Sundberg send Nuisance Ordinance violation notices to; Walter Spichiger of 7490 Rohl Road, Barry Slaughenhaupt of 8757 Williams Road, Ronald Dandar of 9647 Prindle Road, Jason Bartlett of 9613 Route 89, and Dora Keith of 8945 Dougan Road. Matthew Braine of 10848 Station Road is to receive a Zoning Ordinance Violation Notice for having a second mobile home on his property. Patrick Kloss of 8810 Williams Road is to receive a letter from Kurt Sundberg, reminding him to continue clean up. Kevin Bartlett seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

Sal Fedele made a motion to adjourn. Kevin Bartlett seconded. No public comment was made. Motion carried unanimously.
