

May 29, 2018, 7:00 P.M., Greenfield Township Municipal Building, a regular meeting of the Greenfield Township Board of Supervisors.

Present: Steve Rathmann, Sal Fedele and Renee Wagner. Kevin Bartlett was absent.

No public was in attendance.

The Harborcreek Township multi-municipal seal coat bids were opened. The low bid was from Suit Kote at \$ 1.142 per square yard. Total contract price for the 64,000 square yards bid is \$ 73, 088.00. \$ 62,000.00 was budgeted, but that did not include seal coat for Townley Run Drive. Mark Corey will forward bid documents for signing at the next meeting.

The issue of the Department of Environmental Protection not issuing brine permits was discussed. There is pending legislation in both the House and Senate that would correct the legal issue and allow permits to be issued. Information regarding contacting the legislators has been posted on the Township website and Facebook page. The board approved grading, as necessary, before it rains to help pack the material.

Russell Standard Corporation has agreed to supply the asphalt and concrete at the unit prices for the Greenfield Community Park improvements. DCNR has not given final approval.

Resumes had been received and reviewed. Interviews had been conducted. Multiple health insurance coverage options and costs were reviewed. PSATS was the only carrier that would provide coverage for one employee. Other carriers required that at least 50% of the employees be enrolled in the plan. The current four employees do not need health insurance coverage, as they are covered under their spouses work plan and have signed the health insurance waivers. It was decided to offer PSATS Plan E at no cost to prospective employees. A job offer letter was to be sent to Cory Clabbatz at the starting rate of \$ 16.50/hour (as a CDL licensed employee) and a copy of the proposed health insurance policy. If Cory Clabbatz was not interested, a job offer letter was to be sent to Joseph Skopow at the starting rate of \$ 14.00/hour with an increase to \$ 15.00/hour once he obtains his CDL license, along with a copy of the proposed health insurance policy.

Sal Fedele made a motion to approve Richard (Chris) Bisbee as an authorized user of the Greenfield Township Northwest VISA credit card. A card is to be issued in his name.

Steve Rathmann seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

Steve Rathmann stated that Rathmann Plumbing would be donating the installation of the recently purchased air conditioner in the office. He would have his employees install it.

The Township would be billed for Knorr Electric to wire and connect the unit.

Sal Fedele made a motion to adjourn. Steve Rathmann seconded. No public comment was made. Motion carried unanimously.

Meeting adjourned at 7:50 p.m..
