

June 11, 2018, 7:00 p.m., Greenfield Township Municipal Building, a regular meeting of the Greenfield Township Board of Supervisors.

Present: Steve Rathmann, Sal Fedele, Kevin Bartlett, Renee Wagner, Kurt Sundberg, Chris Bisbee and Paul Hollman.

Sal Fedele stated that Public Comment would be accepted throughout the meeting as items were being discussed and before each vote.

Steve Rathmann made a motion to accept the minutes from the May 14th and May 29th 2018 meetings. Sal Fedele seconded. No public comment was made. Motion carried unanimously.

Renee Wagner presented information regarding an Automated Red Light Enforcement (ARLE) program grant for the replacement of guide rails on Rohl Road. These guide rails were planned to be replaced with the 2017 Dirt & Gravel Roads Low Volume Roads grant, which was not approved. It is a full funding grant. The grant application deadline is July 6, 2018.

Sal Fedele made a motion to apply for a grant for guide rail replacement on Rohl Road, through the Automated Red Light Enforcement (ARLE) program. Kevin Bartlett seconded. No public comment was made. Motion carried unanimously.

The Girts Sand & Gravel bonds and insurance certificates had been received. The contract was signed.

Chris Bisbee reported that Venango Township had graveled Fox Road. The roads are in good shape.

Steve Rathmann made a motion to accept the bid from Suit Kote, for 64,000 square yards of seal coat at \$ 1.142/square yard. This bid was received through the Harborcreek Township joint municipal bid. Kevin Bartlett seconded. No public comment was made. Vote; Sal Fedele - yes, Kevin Bartlett - yes, Steve Rathmann - abstained from voting due to a possible conflict. Motion carried.

A hydraulic line needed to be replaced on the curbside recycling truck.

Russell Standard was obtaining bonds for the asphalt and concrete contract for the Greenfield Community Park improvements.

The Zoning permit report had been forwarded to the Board.

Nothing to report from the Planning Commission.

No subdivisions were presented.

The possibility of the Township making and installing the house number signs currently being provided by the fire company was discussed. There is not anyone to do them at the fire company. Township employees could do them. They could be purchased at the time that new home permits were issued and as needed. Remaining supplies at the Fire Station would be brought to the municipal building. More supplies were needed.

Nothing to report from the Emergency Management Coordinator.

The Zoning Ordinance is under review.

Zoning violation notices to be sent were in process.

Nothing to report on the Employee Handbook review.

Information was presented regarding Armstrong Utilities submission of a franchise agreement. They planned to provide cable, internet and telephone services. Kurt Sundberg

presented information on how other municipalities handle franchises. This was not an exclusive agreement, meaning they would not be the only television/internet/voice utility permitted in the Township. Existing utility providers were discussed. Paul Hollman stated that Spectrum had lines on the poles behind his house. More information will be obtained, specifically a coverage map and if it will be fiber optic service (FiOS).

No seminars or schools were available.

Correspondence regarding HB2154 to allow DEP to issue brine permits for conventional well brine was discussed. Legislators have been contacted. Residents calling about dust have been given the legislators' contact information.

Sal Fedele made a motion to hire Joseph Skopow on a ninety-day probation period, at the rate of \$ 14.00/hour and increasing to \$ 16.50/hour once he obtains his CDL license. After the ninety days, upon appointment as full time hire, he will be eligible for all benefits including health coverage through PSATS Plan E. He will start after the two weeks notice is complete with his current employee. Steve Rathmann seconded. No public comment was made. Motion carried unanimously.

Sal Fedele made a motion to approve payment of Northwest Savings 2496 through 2522 and PLGIT 10033 through 10056. Kevin Bartlett seconded. No public comment was made. Motion carried unanimously.

Sal Fedele made a motion to adjourn. Steve Rathmann seconded. No public comment was made. Motion carried unanimously.
