

April 23, 2019, 7:00 P.M., Greenfield Township Municipal Building, a regular meeting of the Greenfield Township Board of Supervisors.

Present: Steve Rathmann, Kevin Bartlett, Renee Wagner and Chris Bisbee. Sal Fedele was absent.

Steve Rathmann stated that Public Comment would be accepted throughout the meeting as items were being discussed and before each vote. No public was present.

Chris Bisbee reported that the roads were in good shape. South Dougan had a few soft spots. The grader had been out.

Steve Rathmann made a motion to adopt Resolution 2019-9, removing the 10-ton weight limit posting from Township roads. Kevin Bartlett seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

The results of the Erie Area Council of Governments bids were reviewed.

Steve Rathmann made a motion to contract with the following suppliers - Girts for # 57 stone \$ 8.48/ton and 2A \$7.65/ton, Safford for Antiskid \$ 5.25/ton and #8 stone \$ 5.25/ton, ACA for #3 stone \$ 9.00/ton, and Lindy Paving for cold patch at \$ 85.00/ton. Kevin Bartlett seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

Steve Rathmann made a motion to reject the bid from Keystone Stabilization at \$ 83,740.00 for Full Depth Reclamation, due to budget constraints. Kevin Bartlett seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

Nothing to report on Recycling.

Renee Wagner reported that the rain gardens and landscaping could be done without bidding. Drainage issues were discussed.

No action was taken on the Armstrong Franchise Agreement Addendum.

Steve Rathmann made a motion to send Nuisance Ordinance violation letters to Brian Dandar owner 9647 Prindle Rd., William Spichiger owner 7490 Rohl Rd., Patrick Kloss owner 8810 Williams Rd., and Hartman Acres owner 9831 German Rd. Kevin Bartlett seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

No action was taken on correspondence regarding the Erie County Complete Count Committee.

No Final Public Comment was received.

Steve Rathmann made a motion to adjourn. Kevin Bartlett seconded. No public was present to comment. Motion carried unanimously.
