Kevin Bartlett made a motion to accept the low bid for Full Depth Reclamation of Rohl Road, from Keystone Stabilization, in the contract amount of \$ 71,258.00, as bid in the Erie Area Council of Governments bid. The contract includes a chemical cure coat instead of a prime seal coat, which meets the PennDOT specifications of the bid. Steve Rathmann seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

Chris Bisbee stated that the roads were not in bad shape. Brining of the roads was discussed. Chris Bisbee is to contact the driver to go over coverage of the roads.

Clean Up Days were postponed indefinitely.

Kevin Bartlett made a motion to adopt Resolution 2020-9, eliminating the 10% penalty on Real Estate taxes for the remainder of 2020. Steve Rathmann seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

Kevin Bartlett made a motion to adjourn. Steve Rathmann seconded. Motion carried unanimously.
