Kevin Bartlett stated that Public Comment would be accepted throughout the meeting as items were being discussed and before each vote. No public was present in the meeting.

Steve Rathmann made a motion to adopt the minutes from the May 11th meeting. Sal Fedele seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

The Treasurer's Report was reviewed.

Sal Fedele submitted a report on behalf of Chris Bisbee. Approximately 800 tons of millings have been hauled in from I-86 and 990 tons of milling were hauled in from Route 20. More millings will be hauled in this week. This material is free of charge. The brine truck is fixed and will be spreading brine on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday this week. Mowing was being done in the north east corner of the Township. Three of the seven pipes have been replaced. Two more will be done in the next week. Stone has been placed in the ditches on Palmer Road. Concrete will be poured at the small pavilion at the Park.

Kevin Bartlett made a motion to accept the Act 13 grant from Erie County to rebuild the Wilson Road bridge over Darrow Brook. The Township will be responsible for \$48,000.00 and the grant will furnish \$72,000.00. Steve Rathmann seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

Zoning permits had been submitted for review.

No Subdivisions were presented.

Nothing from the Planning Commission.

Steve Rathmann reported that the Hirtzel Foundation was requesting more information for the grant for the new fire station. Kevin Bartlett reported that EMS calls were down, due to the Coronavirus.

Attorney Kurt Sundberg had revised the Zoning Ordinance and would be forwarding a copy for review by Renee Wagner.

Property violation notices on Prindle Road and South Dougan Road were discussed. They will both be checked.

The Swanson violation notice was on hold until July. The violation notice for Kloss was to proceed as soon as the District Justice office can schedule the hearing.

The process to add the Joseph Adameck properties to the Agriculture Security Area included review by the Agriculture Security Area Committee. Currently Kevin Bartlett, Roger

Gilkinson and Jeff Miller were on the committee. The law required a business person be on the committee. Board members will try to find someone to serve on the committee.

Clean up days were scheduled for July 10th from 7:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. and July 11th from 8:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m.

Steve Rathmann made a motion to accept the bid from Melzer's Fuel Service for a three-year contract for unleaded and diesel fuel for the Fire Company and Township as bid through the

Erie Area Council of Governments bid. Sal Fedele seconded. Motion carried unanimously. The Full Depth Reclamation seminar will be held by webinar on June 10th. All crew members will attend.

The Resolution from McKean Township urging the Governor to change the Coronavirus stage of business openings and restrictions from yellow to green was reviewed. No action was taken.

No final public comment.

Steve Rathmann made a motion to pay the invoices as presented, Northwest 3121 through 3148 and PLGIT 10612 through 10635. Sal Fedele seconded. Motion carried unanimously. Sal Fedele made a motion to adjourn. Kevin Bartlett seconded. Motion carried unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 7:44 p.m..
