October 6, 2020, 7:00 P.M., Greenfield Township Municipal Building, a special meeting for a budget workshop. The meeting was held by Zoom meetings due to the Coronavirus. The change in meeting location was posted at the Township building and left on the answering machine.

Present: Steve Rathmann, Sal Fedele, Kevin Bartlett, Renee Wagner and Chris Bisbee. No public was in attendance to make Public Comment.

The budget notes, capital improvement plan, income and expense worksheets and proposed projects were reviewed and discussed. The employee compensation and benefits Resolution 2020-3 was reviewed. Employee raises were set at \$1.00 per hour for Municipal Services Crew members, salary set at \$40,000.00 for Secretary/Treasurer, and salary set at \$90.00 per week for maintenance at the Greenfield Community Park. The Day after Thanksgiving was added as a paid holiday. If there was snow the Crew would be expected to come in. One personal day was added with a maximum of eight days to be carried forward. Kevin Bartlett stated that if the online fundraising currently being conducted by the Greenfield Township Volunteer Fire Company, continued as it has, there may not be the need for the Township's donation of \$15,000.00. This amount was given to cut down on requiring firefighters participating in fundraisers. The amount remained budgeted and can be shifted to Road Maintenance later.

The ventilation system in the office was discussed. Materials will be ordered through IRR Supply and installed by the Municipal Services Crew.

Sal Fedele made a motion to adopt Resolution 2020-13 accepting the law firm of MacDonald, Illig, Jones & Britton, LLP as the conductor of Judicial Tax Sales for the next three years. Steve Rathmann seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

No public was present for final public comment.

Sal Fedele made a motion to adjourn. Kevin Bartlett seconded. Motion carried unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 8:46 p.m..
