

October 12, 2020, 7:00 P.M., Greenfield Township Municipal Building, a regular meeting of the Greenfield Township Board of Supervisors. The meeting was held by Zoom meetings, due to the Coronavirus. Notice of the meeting site change was posted at the Township Building and listed on the answering machine.

Present: Steve Rathmann, Sal Fedele, Kevin Bartlett, Renee Wagner and Chris Bisbee.

Kevin Bartlett stated that Public Comment would be accepted throughout the meeting as items were being discussed and before each vote. No public was present in the meeting.

Sal Fedele made a motion to adopt the minutes from the September 14th and October 6th meetings. Steve Rathmann seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

The Treasurer's Report was reviewed.

Chris Bisbee reported that recent rains had locked the road surfaces. More than 3000 feet of drain tile had been installed. Plow trucks were ready. They were working on DSA projects. They would be berming Rohl Road. The potholes on Wilson Road would be filled on Thursday or Friday, with remaining material put on Wildman Road. There were seven or eight more days of hauling material to the Township building. The Finn Road DSA project turned out great.

The replacement of the 1996 Mack truck was discussed. Specifications were discussed. Watching Municipal auction sites was discussed. The benefits of buying new were discussed. COSTARS and a new Federal program called Source were discussed. Other equipment is holding up well, no major repairs anticipated.

The Greenfield Community Park restrooms will be closed, once the nitrite/nitrate testing is done for the last quarter.

No questions on Zoning permits submitted for review.

No Subdivisions were presented.

Nothing to report from the Planning Commission.

Nothing new to report from the Greenfield Township Volunteer Fire Company. The FEMA grant money had been deposited.

Revisions to the Zoning Ordinance were being reviewed by Renee Wagner.

No action was taken on violation notices.

The Adameck Agriculture Security Area application will be granted a deemed approval after October 31st. Kurt Sundberg will handle the recording at the Court House.

Kevin Bartlett stated that he was approached about planting a memorial tree at the Greenfield Community Park. The area to be planted will be marked out. Varieties that have done well will be shared.

No final public comment.

Sal Fedele made a motion to pay the invoices as presented, Northwest 3133 through 3254 and PLGIT 10715 through 10741. Steve Rathmann seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

Sal Fedele made a motion to adjourn. Kevin Bartlett seconded. Motion carried unanimously.
