Kevin Bartlett stated that Public Comment would be accepted throughout the meeting as items were being discussed and before each vote. No public was present.

The American Rescue Plan rulings on allowable expenditures have not been finalized, with no date given for finalization.

Discussion regarding hiring an additional employee was held off until January.
