

December 30, 2021, 7:00 P.M., Greenfield Township Municipal Building, a special meeting of the Greenfield Township Board of Supervisors.

Present: Steve Rathmann, Sal Fedele, Kevin Bartlett, Renee Wagner and Brian Brown.

Kevin Bartlett stated that Public Comment would be accepted throughout the meeting as items were being discussed and before each vote.

Renee Wagner reported for the record that this meeting was advertised in the Erie Times-News on December 9, 2021.

The proposed budget was advertised on December 9, 2021 as being available for inspection.

No comments were received.

Sal Fedele made a motion to adopt Resolution 2021-16 setting the tax millage for 2022 at 2.34 mills. Steve Rathmann seconded. No public comment was made. Motion carried unanimously.

Sal Fedele made a motion to adopt Resolution 2021-17 adopting the 2022 Budget as proposed. Steve Rathmann seconded. No public comment was made. Motion carried unanimously.

Sal Fedele made a motion to expend Liquid Fuels money as budgeted for 2022. Steve Rathmann seconded. No public comment was made. Motion carried unanimously.

Sal Fedele made a motion to adopt Resolution 2021-18, establishing the Health Insurance Plan and setting the monthly waiver fee at \$ 150.00. Steve Rathmann seconded. No public comment was made. Motion carried unanimously.

Nothing to report on Roads.

Kevin Bartlett made a motion to amend the agenda to discuss quarantine times. Sal Fedele seconded. No public comment was made. Motion carried unanimously.

The length of the quarantine after exposure or actual symptoms had been reduced by the Center for Disease Control (CDC) to five days and then five days of masking. One of the crew had called in a positive test and was showing symptoms on Wednesday. Because the crew was exposed on Monday and Tuesday, they were told to quarantine. The Board agreed that the remainder of the crew should quarantine through Sunday and return Monday wearing masks, unless they had symptoms. All employees should quarantine for five days after a positive test or symptoms. They should return when symptoms subside, anytime after five days and wear a mask.

Nothing to report on Recreation.

No Old Business was presented.

No New Business was presented.

A quote to replace the garage door lifter on one of the bays was approved, as budgeted.

The repair of one of the plow trucks was discussed.

No final public comment was made.

Sal Fedele made a motion to adjourn. Steve Rathmann seconded. No public comment was made. Motion carried unanimously.
