

October 29, 2024, 7:05 P.M., Greenfield Township Municipal Building, a regular meeting of the Greenfield Township Board of Supervisors.

Present: Kevin Bartlett, Brian Brown, Travis Clabatz, Renee Wagner and Joe Heslop.

No public was in attendance to make Public Comment.

Joe Heslop reported that the crew was mowing as needed, ditching as needed, had bermed the whole Township, set up the plow trucks for winter, and stored summer equipment for the winter. A PA One Call had been placed for the Multi Use Court construction at the Park. The turnaround area on Prindle Road was discussed. The Tarr Road soft spot was discussed. The Fall Road Inspection was rescheduled for November 4<sup>th</sup> at 4:00 p.m..

The Department of Conservation and Natural Resources had given approval to start the earth moving and construction of the base for the Multi Use Court at the Greenfield Community Park. Security cameras and signs will be installed. The prepared area will be barricaded.

No Old Business was presented.

No New Business was presented.

Renee Wagner reviewed the information that had been received since the October 8<sup>th</sup> Budget Workshop. Reserve funds and current bank balances were reviewed.

Kevin Bartlett made a motion to scrap the 1973 Blaw Knox Paver purchased from Harborcreek Township. Parts were not available for repairs. The belt was broken and the machine had hardened asphalt in it. Brian Brown seconded. Purchasing equipment "sight unseen" was discussed. Motion carried unanimously.

Regarding Employee Benefits, the budget was increased to allow for an increase in pay for all employees of \$ 1.00/hour. This will not be finalized until the organization meeting on January 6, 2025.

The Health Insurance Waiver information was reviewed and will be decided at the December meeting.

The balance of funding available for road projects will be budgeted to road maintenance, with the exact surfacing project to be determined before budget adoption or in the Spring of 2025.

No Final Public Comment.

Kevin Bartlett made a motion to pay the invoices as presented. Travis Clabatz seconded. Motion carried unanimously.
