

March 25, 2025, 7:00 P.M., Greenfield Township Municipal Building, a regular meeting of the Greenfield Township Board of Supervisors.

Present: Kevin Bartlett, Brian Brown, Travis Clabbatz, Renee Wagner and Joseph Heslop. No residents were present for the reading of the Public Comment policy.

Joe Heslop reported that the crew had graded and planed the roads when possible, equipment was being serviced, the crosspipe on Rich Hill Road was unplugged, Morgan Road and Raymond Road were closed due to soft spots, road signs were being made up and replaced as needed, and the ATV signs had been ordered. Morgan Road and Raymond Road were firming up. Prindle Road has some bad spots. Ashton Road is starting to come apart near where the blacktop and tiling was done last year. The Wilson Road millings area was discussed. The millings will be hauled out, the road will be notched as done in the Dirt & Gravel Roads projects, tiling and ditching will be done, and 6" of 2RC will be placed. The edges of the road will be pulled back in. Brian Brown asked about putting millings on Calkins Road and surfacing. This project was not budgeted. The extra money was put into road maintenance.

The Board reviewed the draft of Ordinance 2025-3, the Solar Energy System Ordinance, amending the Zoning Ordinance, as prepared by Attorney Kurt Sundberg. Setbacks of 100' were suggested by the Board. Provisions for screening and buffering that were in sample ordinances were recommended to be added.

Brian Brown made a motion to accept the draft Ordinance 2025-3, the Solar Energy System Ordinance, amending the Zoning Ordinance, with the setback, screening and buffering requirements. Travis Clabbatz seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

No old business.

Under new business, Brian Brown requested that the monthly meetings be changed to the second Tuesday of the month. This was not on the agenda for discussion. Changing the date would result in spending money to re-advertise. This item will be put on the April 14th agenda.

No public was present to comment.

Kevin Bartlett made a motion to adjourn. Travis Clabbatz seconded. Motion carried unanimously.
