Present: Kevin Bartlett, Travis Clabbatz, Renee Wagner and Joe Heslop. Attorney Kurt Sundberg attended by phone. Brian Brown was absent.

No one was present for the Public Comment announcement.

Kevin Bartlett made a motion to adopt the minutes from the July 13th meeting. Travis Clabbatz seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

The Treasurer's Report was reviewed.

Joe Heslop stated that the crew had been working on the Morgan Road Dirt & Gravel grant project, were hauling in the remaining material for the Township, building up roads as needed (South Dougan, Ashton and Davis where the soft spots were in the Spring), grading roads as needed, mowing around the Township roads, and getting the plow trucks ready and inspected. He has scheduled a meeting for August 13th with Tom McClure to discuss the proposed 2027 dirt & Gravel Roads grant application for Ashton Road. He has scheduled a meeting for August 25th with Troy Cyphert to review Wilson Road as a possible PennDOT Multi Modal Grant application.

Renee Wagner reported that the Township cameras were being installed at the Park, through a grant from the Hirtzel Foundation.

Zoning permits were reviewed.

Nothing to report from the Planning Commission.

No Subdivisions were presented.

Kevin Bartlett reported that all of the information requested for the grant for the new Fire Station had been forwarded to Washington. They could be breaking ground in a week.

Renee Wagner will forward sample ordinances for Data Center regulations to Kurt Sundberg.
